

Privacy Policy for SecureView

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes how SecureView ("we," "us," or "our") handles user data. We are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring that your browsing history remains secure and under your control.

2. Information We Access and Collect

To provide the core functionality of categorizing your browsing habits, our extension requires the following permissions:

- **Browsing History (history permission):** We access your local Chrome browsing history (URLs and page titles) to analyze and categorize your activity.
- **Storage:** We may store the resulting category metadata locally in your browser's secure storage.

3. How Data is Processed (Local-First AI)

We prioritize a **Local-First** approach to data privacy:

- **On-Device Processing:** All browsing history analysis is performed by a Small Language Model (SLM) running **locally** on your device.
- **No Data Exfiltration:** Your raw browsing history (URLs, titles, or timestamps) is **never** uploaded to our servers, nor is it sent to any third-party AI providers.
- **Categorization Metadata:** Only the high-level categories generated by the local model are stored locally to show you your personalized view.

4. Data Usage and "Limited Use" Disclosure

In compliance with the Google Chrome Web Store User Data Policy, we declare that:

- We use the history data **only** to provide the user-facing feature of browsing categorization.
- We do **not** sell your data to third parties.
- We do **not** use your data for advertising purposes or creditworthiness assessments.
- We do **not** use your data to train global AI models; any model "learning" is confined to your local instance.

5. Data Retention and Deletion

- **Local Storage:** All data processed by the extension is stored locally in your browser.
- **User Control:** You can clear the extension's data at any time through the extension settings or by uninstalling the extension. Since we do not store your data on our servers, deleting the extension removes all associated data from our reach.

6. Security

We implement industry-standard security practices to protect the data stored within the extension's local sandbox. Since no data is transmitted over the internet, the primary security of your data relies on your local device and browser security.

7. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you of any changes by updating the "Last Updated" date at the top of this policy and, where appropriate, providing a notice within the extension UI.
