SecureView is a productivity tool designed to help users access, view, and categorize their own browser history. The Extension functions as a local interface; it does not provide cloud synchronization or external data backup.

3. Data Privacy & Local Storage

- **Local-Only Processing:** You acknowledge that SecureView processes your browsing history locally on your device.
- **No Data Collection:** The developer of SecureView does not collect, store, or have access to your browsing history, metadata, or personal information.
- **IndexedDB:** Data is stored within your browser's **IndexedDB**. If you clear your browser data or uninstall the extension, this local data may be permanently deleted.

4. User Responsibilities

- **Device Security:** Since your data is stored locally, the security of your categorized history depends on the security of your physical device and browser profile.
- **Acceptable Use:** You agree not to use the Extension for any illegal purposes or to attempt to reverse-engineer the Extension's underlying code.

The software, code, logos, and design of SecureView are the intellectual property of the developer. You are granted a personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Extension for personal or professional use.
